Isaiah 53:11 many to be accounted righteous

Habakkuk 2:4 The righteous shall live by faith

Luke 24:47 that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in His name

John 1:12-13 to all who did receive Him, who believed in His name

John 1:29 Behold the Lamb of God!

John 3:5 Unless one is born of water and the Spirit...

John 3:14-18 Whoever believes in Him is not condemned

Rom 4:16 on faith, in order that the promise may rest on grace and be guaranteed

Rom 5: 1 justified by faith, we have peace with God

Rom 5: 2 Through Him we have also obtained access

Rom 5:20 The law came in to increase the trespass

Rom 7:7 You shall not covet

Rom 8:7-8 Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

Rom 10: 4 Christ is the end of the law for righteousness ...

Rom 10:10 With the heart one believes and is justified.

Rom 10:17 Faith comes from hearing

Rom 11:6 if it is by grace, it no longer on the basis of works

Rom 14:23 Whatever does not proceed from faith is sin.

I Cor 1:30 our wisdom and our righteousness and sanctification and redemption

I Cor 15:56 The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law

Gal 2:16 believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith

Gal 2:21 if righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died in vain
